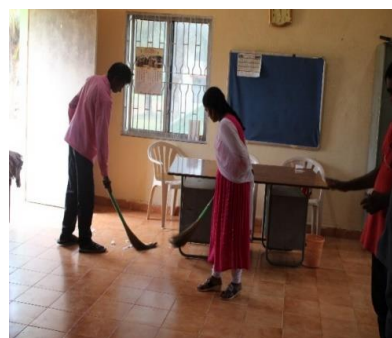
## 1. ICAR-Indian Institute of Oil Palm Research, Pedavegi

The tools and implements were neatly arranged in an orderly manner to ensure easy access and proper maintenance. In addition, pesticides and insecticides were systematically placed and safely stored to promote both cleanliness and workplace safety. This effort not only enhanced the overall appearance of the store room but also improved efficiency, hygiene, and safety in day-to-day farm operations.

25.09. 25	<p>As part of the date-wise action plan for "Swachhta Hi Sewa" with the theme "Swachhotsav," a cleanliness drive titled "Ek Din, Ek Ghanta, Ek Sath – Shramdan" was conducted under the guidance of Dr. M. Mohanty, Director, ICAR-IISS, Bhopal. All regular farm employees, DPL staff of the Farm and Horticulture Management sections, and SRFs and assistants of CRP CA participated in the event. The cleanliness drive began from the main road, clearing grasses, bushes, and accumulated dirt and debris from the drainage channels on both sides. Using sickles, spades, straw pullers, and slashers, the vegetation was removed and properly disposed of at the composting material stacks near Farm Pond No. 3 along the boundary wall. The second site, "Neem Road," was addressed next, where monsoon growth had caused dense vegetation. Grasses and bushes were cut using brush cutters and sickles, collected with panja tools, and transported to the composting site along the rear boundary wall. These collected grasses, bushes, and other biodegradable materials are periodically processed by the institute's two compost-making units, where they are converted into nutrient-rich compost. This compost is subsequently used to enrich the soil of experimental plots and farm areas within the institute, promoting sustainable waste management and enhancing soil fertility.</p>
