

Guidelines for Adjunct Faculty in the Indian Agricultural Universities

1. The Indian Council of Agricultural Research's (ICAR's) support for the provision of adjunct faculty in an Agricultural University (AU) is catalytic in nature, subject to the specified funds in the given financial year allocated/granted for this purpose. The ICAR will only partially meet the expenses on adjunct faculty in the Indian Agricultural Universities.
2. The Adjunct faculty should be an eminent teacher having recognition at national/international level and having outstanding published work.
3. Adjunct faculty must be treated as University Guest at the Agricultural University (AU) and should be provided free University accommodation along with TA/DA to be paid by the University.
4. The honorarium to the Adjunct faculty shall be generally @ Rs. 1,000/- per day stay or as deemed fit by the concerned AU.
5. The Adjunct faculty shall deliver at least 18 lectures in a maximum of two spells and spend at least 15 days in a year at the University campus or its constituent Colleges.
6. The Adjunct faculty shall deliver lectures and render help and guidance pertaining to the education and research programmes at the concerned AU, especially help in developing research projects and providing guidance to scientists of the University.
7. The Agricultural University through its Faculty Chairman/Dean shall identify eminent teachers as adjunct faculty based on their research, teaching or extension accomplishment and obtain approval/endorsement of /by the Academic Council of the University.
